



100 CLUB RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The “numbers” will be issued to members on a first come, first served basis and will only be available from the administrator of the lottery.
2. Each “number” is deemed to have been reserved for one year and purchased for £12.
3. The total fee for each number purchased will be paid annually in advance by bank transfer to ‘Hurstbourne Tarrant Community Centre’, a/c 06189921, sort code: 30-90-21, ref: ‘[your initials] 100 Club’; or by annual standing order.
4. In the event that it is not possible to pay the annual fee by BACS or standing order, payment by cash or cheque (made payable to Hurstbourne Tarrant Community Centre) is acceptable.
5. Individuals can become members at any time during the year having paid the appropriate fee and will be entered into the next monthly draw.
6. To qualify for a monthly draw the member must have paid their fee covering the respective monthly draw to be able to participate.
7. Each number purchased will be entered into the monthly draw. When a number is drawn out it will be eliminated from any remaining draws within that month.
8. There are no restrictions in the quantity of numbers purchased by applicants, but applicants must be over 16 years of age to participate.

10. The draws will take place normally on a monthly basis. Where it is not possible to undertake a draw within the specific month, the draw will be carried forward and drawn along with the following month(s) draws.
11. The winners will be advised by e-mail (or if necessary by telephone) as soon as practicable after the draw has taken place.
12. The results will also be published in the Parish Magazine and on the Community Centre web site at www.hbtcommunitycentre.org.uk
13. All prize money will be paid out by bank transfer, unless an alternative option has been arranged with the administrator.
14. The total income collected will be split 50% towards prize money and 50% to Community Centre funds.
15. The prize fund will be split into 12 monthly sets of draws each consisting of three prizes split as follows: one of 50% (first); one of 35% (second); and one of 15% (third); rounded to the nearest pound.
16. In a dispute, the decision of the administrator is final.
